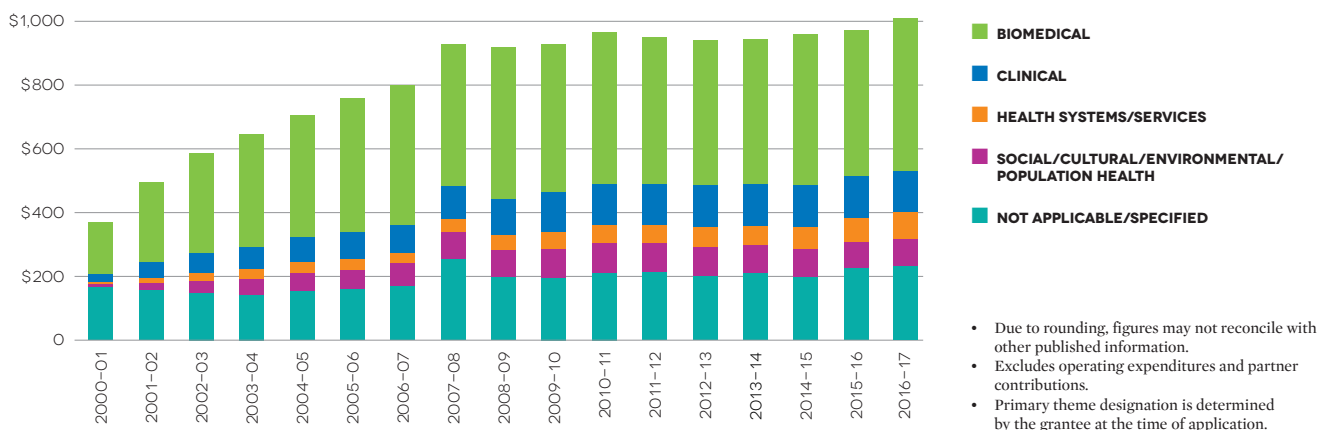


CIHR IN NUMBERS 2016-17

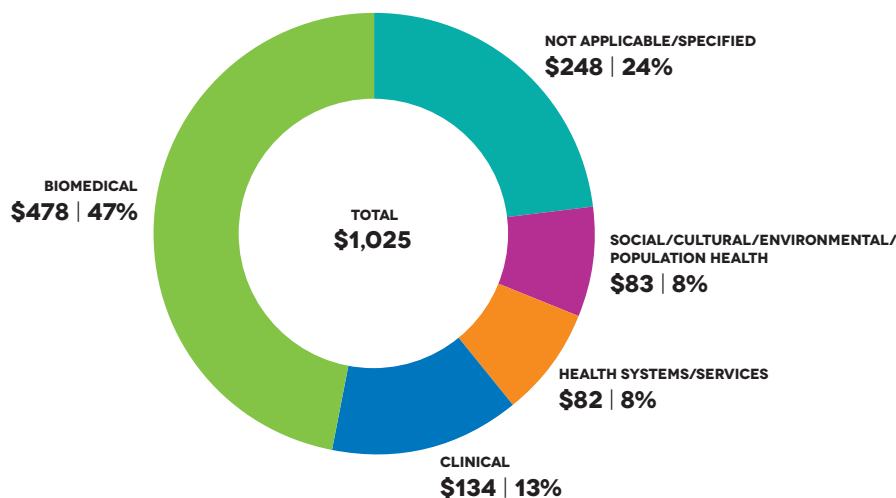

CIHR INVESTMENTS BY PRIMARY THEME 2016-17 (IN MILLIONS OF DOLLARS)

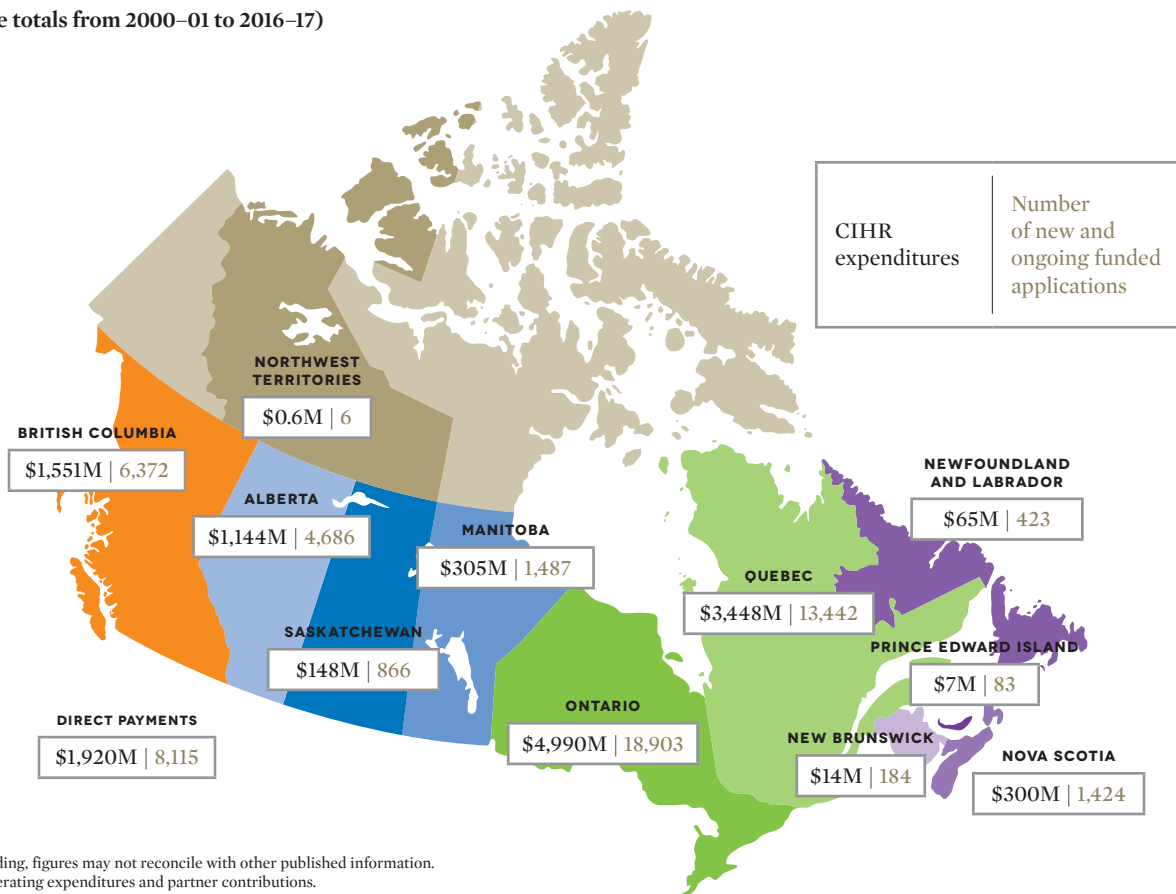

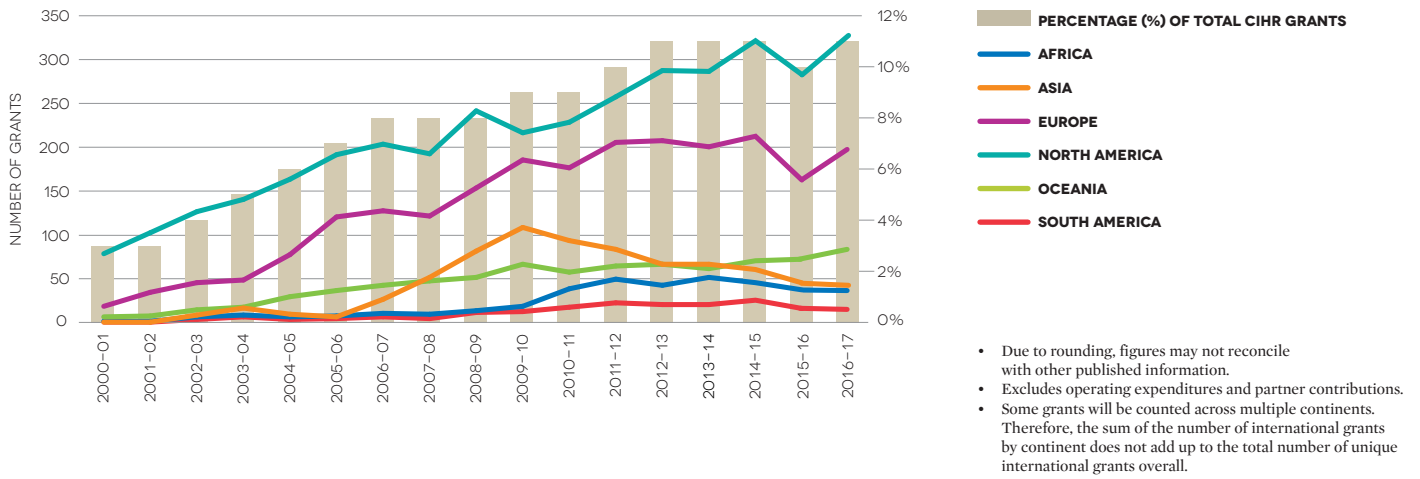

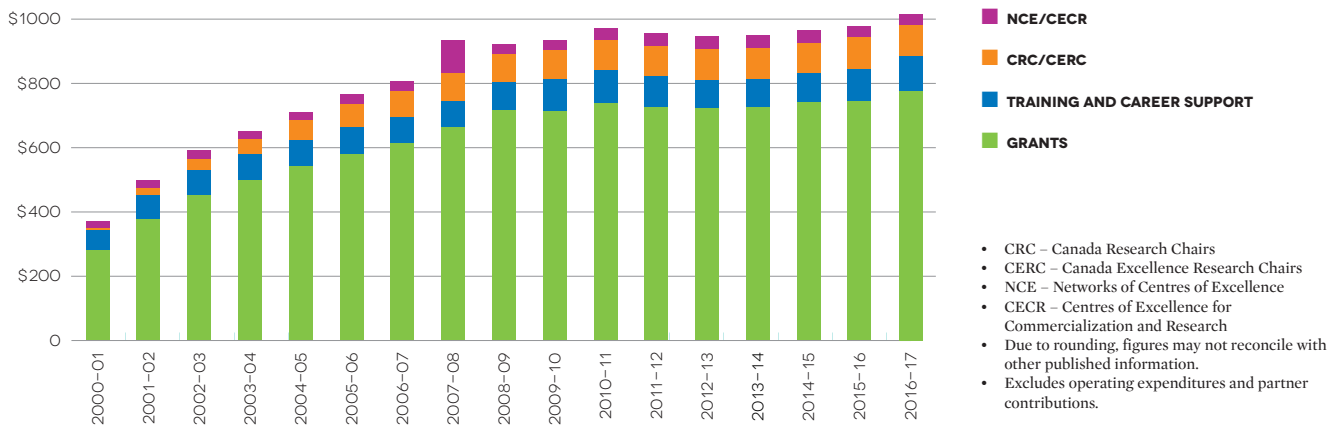
CIHR INVESTMENTS BY REGION (cumulative totals from 2000-01 to 2016-17)



CIHR INVESTMENTS – INTERNATIONAL LINKAGES SINCE 2000–01

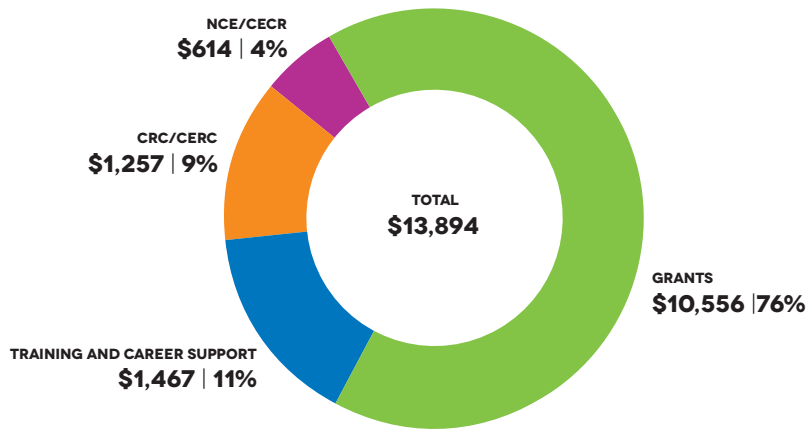


CIHR INVESTMENTS BY PROGRAM TYPE SINCE 2000–01 (IN MILLIONS OF DOLLARS)



CIHR CUMULATIVE INVESTMENTS BY PROGRAM TYPE (IN MILLIONS OF DOLLARS)

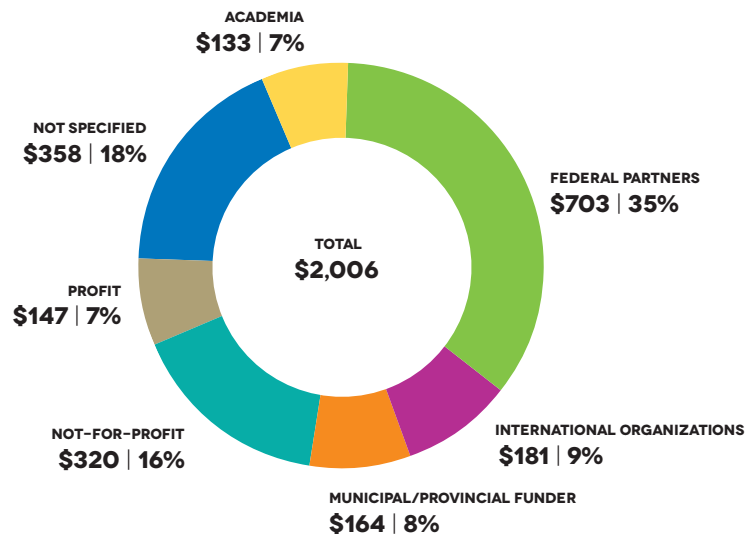
